



Medical and Non-Medical Mandatory Requirements for **PARAMEDIC (PARA)**

Years 1 & 2 (semesters 1 & 3)

Your program requires that you provide proof of the following documentation prior to starting any of your program's lab/clinical components. Please connect with your Placement Coordinator if you have questions.

Please note...

- All requirements must remain current/up to date throughout the duration of your labs/clinical placement.
- Original documents will be required for uploading to a third-party provider for verification.
- Please ensure you attain and upload these documents for your program and schedule an ERV review prior to your clearance deadline – September 30th in Semester 1 for Fall program-start students and January 31st for Winter program-start students, and June 30th in semester 3 for all students

Medical Requirements

- Tetanus/Diphtheria (proof of primary series (3 doses), last dose within 10 years)
- Pertussis (proof of adult dose of Tdap received on or after 18th birthday)
- Measles/Mumps/Rubella - MMR (2 doses of vaccine or proof of immunity)
- Hepatitis B (vaccine records showing proof of a primary series of Hepatitis B vaccines. A lab blood test must be obtained for evidence of immunity(antigen/antibody).
- Varicella (vaccine records of 2 doses or proof of immunity)
- Tuberculosis Screening (documentation of 2-step Mantoux skin test, subsequent 1-Step TB test required annually)
- Polio (proof of initial primary series or adult primary series of 3 doses)
- Influenza vaccine (obtained annually when vaccination becomes available)
- COVID-19 Immunization (proof of vaccination recognized by Health Canada for dose #1 and dose #2 or if no previous COVID-19 vaccinations only require 1 dose of the XBB formulation)
- Communicable Diseases Declaration Form (Physician signature required)

Non-medical Requirements

- CPR-Level BLS/HCP (valid for 1 year)
- Standard First Aid (valid for 3 years)
- Level 3 Vulnerable Sector Police Record Screening (required annually)
- Mask Fit N95-3M Models (valid for 2 years)
- WHMIS Training (valid for 1 year)
- Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Certificate (AODA) (does not expire)
- Worker Health and Safety Awareness in 4 Steps (OHSA Bill 18) (does not expire)
- Student Declaration of Understanding (WSIB)

Further communication and instructions will be provided to you. Upper year students will require renewals of the items that have expiry dates.
